### Collaborating to Create Change

In July, 2017, the average age of children diagnosed with Autism in Flagler and Volusia Counties was **7.9 years old**.

Help Me Grow and UWVFC funded partners collaborated to increase outreach and early intervention.

Now, the average diagnosis age locally is **5.9 years old**.

### IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

**139** Pre-K students connected to literacy mentors through **ReadingPals**

**\$316,761** in Tax Refunds through **VITA** program

**182** Families connected to resources for their children through **Help Me Grow**

**1,432** calls to **211** for referrals for income support, food assistance, disaster services, and crisis intervention

**12,000** pounds of food collected and donated to Flagler food banks by **Women United Flagler's Chicks with Cans**

**\$2,000** in scholarships given to two FPC and Matanzas students by **Women United Flagler**

**\$8,500** granted by **Women United Flagler** to 6 nonprofits serving women and children
